

James R. Trimble (1885 – 1954)

ALLPORT- James R. Trimble, 68, a resident of Morrisdale R. D. for the past 22 years, died at the Philipsburg State Hospital yesterday at 7:30 p. m. where he had been a patient for the past two months.

The deceased was born November 4, 1885, at Horton, Pa., a son of Thomas and Gertrude Colmar Trimble. He married to the former Esther Houdeshell who survives him, June 18, 1926.
